

Mrs. Sarah Lefler Dies in Daughter's Home Near Maryville

Mrs. Sarah F. Lefler died at 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. A. H. Hughes, northwest of Maryville. Mrs. Lefler was born August 10, 1844 at Chaplin, Ky. Sixty-three years ago, two years after her marriage to James Lefler they came to Nodaway county, and had lived in the Burlington Junction and Maryville community since. Mr. Lefler died in 1918. In her early girlhood Mrs. Lefler became a member of the Christian church.

She is survived by one brother, John Romine of Clinton, Ill., five daughters, Mrs. Ella Wiseman of Centralia, Kan., Mrs. Ida White of Kansas City, Mrs. Goldia Ethel Shelton of Sheridan, Wyo., Mrs. Frona Shell and Mrs. Sarah Margaret Hughes of Maryville, two sons, Jesse H. Lefler of Highmore, S. D., and Wilbur C. Lefler of Kansas City. There are also a number of grandchildren and great grandchildren.

The funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the Christian church at Wilcox. Rev. S. D. Harlan of Burlington Junction will conduct the services. Burial will be at the Wilcox cemetery.
