The will has the following provisions; Mary E Ballinger, Mrs. Flora Hughes and Jame-Heilin, grandchildren of deceased. are to receive one-eighteenth each of the estate: Mrs. W. W. Mashin, W. N. Heifin, Susan C. Carter and R. E. Hellin; sons and daughters, are to receive one-sixth each of the estate, while Charles Hellin is to have the remaining sixth with some deductions.

Mrs. Cook was the owner of a large farm near Wilcox. Charles R. Hellin is named as the executor of the will.
