Andrew Jensen, Who Had Lived in County For 72 Years, Dies

Andrew J. Jensen, 87 years of age, a resident of Nodaway county seventy-two years, died at 5 o'clock this morning at his home, 1406 North Mulberry street. He had been in failing health for several years and had been bedfast since February.

Funeral services will be held at 3 o'clock tomorrow afternoon at the Wilcox Methodist church with burial in Wilcox cemetery. Rev. Lester Hall of Massena, Ia., will be in charge.

Palbearers will include Ed Babb, R. L. McGinness, Pete Damgar, George Patterson, John Monticue and Pearl Pence.

Born in Denmark on Christmas day, 1852, Mr. Jensen came to the United States with his parents when he was 10 years of age. The family settled in Dodge County, Neb., and in 1868, moved to a farm near Gullford, where they resided for four years. They then moved to a farm nine miles northwest of Maryville, which was Mr. Jensen's home for forty-nine years before moving to Maryville in 1929.

Mr. Jensen married Miss Bena Michaelson September 5, 1888, when celebrating their golden wedding anniversary two years ago, they held open house for a large number of relatives and friends.

Survivors include the widow; six children, Mrs. E. L. Mitchell, Hopkins; Miss Josephine Jensen of the

home; Mrs. Floyd Huff, Wilcox; Mrs. E. A. Mitchell, S. E. Jensen and Luther Jensen, all of Maryville; thirteen grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. One grandchild preceded him in death. A nephew, Henry N. Moore, whom Mr. Jensen reared as a son, also survives.

Mr. Jensen was a member of the Wilcox Methodist church for many years and was a member of the Maryville church at the time of his death.

Mrs. Bena Jensen Dies; To Hold Funeral Thursday

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon at the Methodist church at Wilcox for Mrs. Bena Jensen, 78 years old, who died at 5:20 o'clock this morning at her home, 1406 North Mulberry street, following an illness of one year.

The Rev. James E. Jones, pastor of the First Methodist church of Maryville, will officiate. Burial will be in the Wilcox cemetery. The body will lie in state at the home from 10:30 o'clock Thursday morning until 1 o'clock that afternoon.

She was born February 19, 1867, in Utah, the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Lars Mickelson. On September 6, 1888, she was married to Andrew J. Jensen, who died July 31, 1940. Mrs. Jensen, a member of the Methodist church, had been a resident of this city sixteen years.

Surviving are two sons, Sorenus E. Jensen and Luther Jensen, Maryville; three daughters, Mrs. Ernest Mitchell, Hopkins; Mrs. Beryl Mitchell, Maryville, and Mrs. Floyd Huff, Wilcox; one brother, Heber Mickelson, Pickering; thirteen grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
